A new and exciting range of products including QuickStats, Census Tables and Community Profiles are now available. They can all be used to access data in a variety of formats to suit your needs. The data was updated in June 2012 with the first release of the 2011 Census data.

QuickStats is a fast, simple way for users to understand an area at a glance and is intended for anyone wanting quick summary information about an area.



TableBuilder allows users the freedom to construct basic to complex tables of data. You can build tables at any geographic area level, ranging from a single Statistical Area Level 1 (SA1) to the whole of Australia.



Community Profiles are excellent tools for researching, planning and analysing geographic areas for a number of social, economic and demographic variables



Census DataPacks contain comprehensive data about people, families and dwellings for all available geographic areas, with associated Geographic Information System digital boundary files.
